Class Routines

- Start time 8:50 – 3:15pm. The door will be locked at 8:55, you will then need to take your child to the office.
- If you are unable to collect your child, contact the school by 3pm
- Children need to bring in a named water bottle each day and a healthy snack (e.g. Fruit if they would like)
- Indoors footwear must be black plimsolls or shoes (no crocs or slippers).
- PE kits should all be labelled and need to include:
 - T-shirt with school logo
 - Jogging trousers and shorts
 - Trainers for outdoor PE

Key Information

- Please close the school gates if you see them open
- Please do not use scooters on the school grounds
- Be mindful of the local residents when parking
- Parents are responsible for children before and after school
- No football on the school site before or after school
- Children should not be accessing the early years apparatus before or after school or at the weekend!

Key Information ctd.

- Contributions – please supply a box of tissues each term.
- All admin that needs to go to the office, please give to the class teacher in a named envelope.
- If your child has any medical/physical condition that we are not aware of please let us know.
- Please ensure that if your child requires an INHALER or EPIPEN that they have this in school and it is in date.
- In the event of sickness or diarrhoea, it is a legal requirement for your child to be kept off school for 48 hours following the last occurrence
- If you change your mobile phone number or e-mail address then please let the office know (if you have not given either of these to the office please do so asap).
- If your child requires Calpol/Paracetamol to come to school then they should really be at home!

Children's Mobile Phones

- If your child is going to walk home unaccompanied and you wish them to carry a mobile phone, they may bring it to school.
- The phone must be turned off and handed to the teacher as soon as the child is in school.
- The child's phone must be clearly labelled with their name.
- Please make sure that your child understands that this phone should only be used when necessary; they should not be walking home with them 'on display'.
- Children need to be aware of appropriate use of their mobile phones on the school premises.

Communication

- Please inform the school of appointments or communicate any issues that arise including a reason for lateness or absence.
- It is very important that you let us know of anything that may affect your child in school. If you should have any situations that arise that could affect the emotion of your child please also inform us. E.g. moving house, illness of close relatives, parent travelling and being away from home.
- We require 2 class reps.


Special Educational Needs/Disabilities- SEND

- Greenway School INCO-(Inclusion Co-ordinator) and Autism Lead is Dani Roe.
- INCO works in partnership with parents/carers, staff and professionals to ensure that pupils with SEND have the appropriate provision and **reasonable adjustments** in place in school.
- SEND policy, School offer and Hertfordshire local offer for SEND is on website.
- All pupils with SEND will have a One Page Profile. This will be shared and targets reviewed with staff and parents/carers.
- Please look out for letters and flyers for courses and opportunities for pupils with SEND, sent via email.
- If you have concerns regarding your child please come and see class teacher and/or INCO.

Home Learning

- Spellings – the children will have spelling rules and examples handed out on Mondays. These will be practised during the week and dictation will be on Fridays.
- English homework will be given out on Friday to be completed and handed in the following Wednesday.
- Maths homework will be given out on Wednesday to be completed and handed in the following Monday.
- Please encourage your child to complete their homework on time and independently.

Reading

- Your child will have a reading record for us and yourselves to communicate in about their reading.
- Your child will be part of a guided reading session once a week and we will communicate how your child has read and offer ideas on what to focus on next. This will be indicated in the reading record with this sign 
- Your child will need to practise reading at home every day. Please write a comment about how they have read and sign the reading record. We will reward your child with house points/stars for reading at home every day.

English

- English learning will be differentiated and children will sometimes be able to self select the appropriate challenge.



- To help your child with English you can practise handwriting, encourage your child to write about trips that they have been on and read to your child to help them to develop their vocabulary. You can also refer to the school website.

Maths

- Your child will be taught Maths every day. The learning will be differentiated and children will sometimes be able to self select the appropriate challenge



- You can help your child at home by viewing our calculation policy which is on our website. You can also play games with your child involving maths, such as snakes and ladders and monopoly. You can use money when visiting the shop, weigh items when making cakes and find other practical ways of involving maths in everyday life.

Marking

- Your child's work will be marked using a pink highlighter, a green highlighter (where appropriate) and a green pen.
- The children will be given the opportunity to read and reflect on their marked work. The homework will be marked with a green pen.
- The children will be rewarded for excellent work through house points and stars. For outstanding effort or achievement children will present their work to Mrs Ellwood for 'Special Awards'.
- Children can receive postcards home for outstanding effort, behaviour and personal achievements.

SRE – Relationships and Sex Education

- It is statutory for Year 6 pupils.
- Will be delivered in the summer term
- More information will be made available to parents nearer the time.

Cycling Proficiency

- This will be offered to all children in Year 6 in the spring term.
- More information will follow.
